With this Privacy Policy Statement, we inform you about the extent to which we may process your personal data (hereinafter short “data”).

B. Data Processing

We process data as part of operating this website. Our data processing also comprises the disclosure of data by means of communication. Any data transmitted to the United States of America are covered by a resolution of adequacy issued by the EU Commission, i.e. the so-called EU-US Privacy Shield. By this resolution, the EU Commission certifies that the warranties for data transmissions to the U.S. based on the principles of the EU-US Privacy Shield comply with the data protection standards in the EU. Insofar as we transmit any data to the U.S., we have indicated the participation of our providers in the EU-US Privacy Shield.

All functions on this website as well as the entire subsequent contract processing are implemented by way of elopage.com, which is a service of [elopay GmbH](http://elopay.com), Skalitzer Str. 138, 10999 Berlin, Germany. The data protection statement with regard to this service by [elopay](http://elopay.com) can be found at www.elopage.com.

We have signed an agreement according to GDPR Article 28 with [elopay GmbH](http://elopay.com) as our contracted service provider, stipulating that all data processing on our behalf shall be performed exclusively to our instructions. [elopay GmbH](http://elopay.com) will not process any data for their own purposes.

The following explains the individual data concerned as well as processing purposes, legal framework, recipients and transmission to third countries.

a. Log File

Your visit to our webpages is logged which includes the processing of the following data: the name of the accessed specific webpage, the date and time of access, the transferred data volume, your browser type and version, your operating system used, the referrer URL (internet address of last visited website), your IP address, and the enquiring provider. This is necessary to ensure the security of our website. We process these data based on our legitimate interests according to GDPR Article 6, paragraph 1, point (f). The Log File will be deleted after a period of 7 days, unless it should be required for clarification or proof of any specific infringement that may have come to our attention within the storage period.

b. Hosting

As part of our hosting, all data to be processed with regard to operating this website are stored. This is necessary to enable the operation of the website. We process these data based on our legitimate interests according to GDPR Article 6, paragraph 1, point (f). For the delivery of our online presence, we use the services of web hosting providers to whom we communicate the above-mentioned data.

c. Contact

If you contact us, your furnished data (name, contact information, as far as provided) and your message will be processed exclusively for the purposes of processing and handling your enquiry. We process these data based on GDPR Article 6, paragraph 1, point (b) or GDPR Article 6, paragraph 1, point (f) for handling your enquiry.

d. Newsletter

We provide a Newsletter to which you can subscribe for receiving regular information about our company and our offering. If you sign up for our newsletter, we will process the data you enter (email address and optional other details). Signing up for the Newsletter follows a “double opt-in” procedure in order to prevent any abuse. Once you have registered, we will send you an email asking you to confirm your registration. Your registration will be recorded in order to prove that the sign-up procedure adheres to legal requirements. This includes the storage of data, i.e. the date and time of registration and confirmation as well as your IP address.

The email requesting your confirmation and the associated data recording are based on our legitimate interest in being able to prove your proper registration according to GDPR Article 6, paragraph 1, point (f). The Newsletter will be mailed based on your consent (registration) according to GDPR Article 6, paragraph 1, point (a).

The above-mentioned data will be transmitted to the following service provider in the U.S. commissioned with the distribution of our Newsletter, i.e. ActiveCampaign, Inc, 1 N Dearborn, 5th Floor, Chicago, IL 60601, U.S.A. (hereinafter “distribution service provider”). The data protection statement of this distribution service provider can be found at www.activecampaign.com/privacy-policy.

e. Participation in Our Online Courses and Contract Implementation

- (1) When you book any of our fee-based online courses, we will process your data for the purpose of implementing the contract relationship between you and us. This data processing complies with GDPR Article 6, paragraph 1, point (b).
- (2) Insofar as we may grant you free access to our online courses for test purposes, the data processing is also based on GDPR Article 6, paragraph 1, point (b), serving our legitimate interest in initiating a potential contract.
- (3) For our online courses (both free and fee-based), we use video functions provided by Wistia Inc. 17 Tudor Street Cambridge, Massachusetts, 02139 U.S.A., phone (888) 494-7842. When you attend such an online course, a connection will be made to the U.S. based servers of Wistia, and we will transmit to those servers your anonymised IP address, the name of your provider and technical information about your browser as well as which videos you have viewed and for how long. - (4) If we should conclude a contract with you, your transaction data (name, date of order, way of payment, date of dispatch and/or receipt, amount and recipient of payment, bank account or credit card information) will be transmitted to the service provider commissioned with implement the payment.

C. Duration of Data Storage

We will store your personal data only for as long as required for the purposes of processing them or until you should withdraw a given consent. In cases where data must be retained in compliance with legal obligations, the storage period for certain data may exceed the needs of those processing purposes and extend up to 10 years.

D. Your Rights as Data Subject

a. Information

Upon request, we will inform you at any time and free of charge about all your personal data that we have stored.

b. Rectification, Erasure, Restriction of Processing (Blocking), Objection

If you should no longer agree with the storage of your personal data, or if the information is no longer correct, we will follow your instructions to either erase or block your data or to make necessary rectifications (as far as possible under applicable law). The same applies, if you should request that your data be only processed with restrictions.

c. Data Portability

Upon request, we will provide you with your data in a common, structured and machine-readable format, allowing you to transmit your data to another controller at your discretion.

d. Complaint

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with a competent supervisory authority.

e. Withdrawal of Consent with Future Effect

You can withdraw any given consent with effect for the future, at any time. Your withdrawal will not affect the lawfulness of data processing prior to the withdrawal.

f. Limitations of Your Rights as Affected Person

Data which we are not able to allocate to a specific data subject, for instance if they were anonymised for the purpose of analytics, are not covered by the aforementioned rights. However, we may be able to provide information about and/or erase, block, rectify or transmit such data to another company/controller upon your request, if you furnish us with further information that will permit proper identification.
